God's Amazing Grace Gracious Strength 1 Corinthians 12:9-10

Grace **Transforms** us enabling us to live according to His will. **Changing us.**Grace **Transcends** us enabling us to live according to His will. **Challenging us.**

God sees fit to work in our lives in such a way so that which interrupts His power and working in our lives is dealt with so that His power is predominant.

1. Sufficient strength – "My grace is sufficient for thee:"

"sufficient" - to be strong, to suffice, to be enough; to be satisfied; to defend

Our understanding of God's grace is an increasing awareness of what He has supplied and that it is enough.

- 2. Superior Strength "for my strength is made perfect in weakness"
 Strength is not found in the Absence of Problems or Difficulties.
- 3. Supplanting Strength "when I am weak, then am I strong."

When we are weak, God's strength is even more evident.

When we are in a dilemma, we see the inability of our own strength and rely on God.

If we immerse ourselves in the strength of the Lord, God's grace will become more visible to us.

- Grace is expedient and prolonged
- Grace is enough and able to provide

- God's grace provides light for victory
- God's grace is visible, even when we do not see it
