The warning of ...

7. Failing the grace of God Hebrews 12:15

"fail" - to fall short of the end; fail to reach the goal; fail to become a partaker; to "fall back from"

We NEED God's grace for Strength.

- 1. The Strategy for avoiding the failing of grace (12-15a)
