Instructional Grace Titus 2:11-14

God saves people from sin and our lives are a demonstration of what God can do in us when He saves us. "teaching" – pedagogue – training – We are under the tutelage of God.

- 1. Grace trains us to Abandon sinful living (12, 14b)
 - a. The initial mindset
- "denying" repudiating; rejecting; renouncing
- b. That mindset is acted upon
 "ungodliness" failure to acknowledge
 reverence for Him
 "worldly lusts" desires that reflect a
 godless culture

Grace is not a license to sin, but a motivation to love God and demonstrate His life-changing power.

- 2. Grace trains us to Affirm right living (12b)
 - a. Inwardly
- "soberly" self-control; restraint
 - b. Outwardly
- "righteously" obeying and living in the ways of the Lord
 - c. Upwardly

"godly" – a new reverence for God If people do not see a change in us by God's power through Salvation, then God is not properly glorified in and through us.

- 3. Grace trains us to Acknowledge God's work (13-14a)
 - a. Look forward (13)
- "Looking for that blessed hope"
- b. Look backward to His love to redeem us and possess us (14)

Grace saves us to discipline and train us to live in a way that honors God.
