1) He was "just" – righteous

- e. Relation of faith "to the saving of his house"
- f. Result of faith "by which he condemned the world"
- g. Reward of faith "became heir of the righteousness"

BAPTISM

We are observing the Scriptural ordinance of Baptism this morning at the close of the service. Only those who have placed their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as their Savior are candidates for baptism because it is an outward picture to demonstrate what has previously taken place in our heart to trust Him and what Jesus did to cleanse us from our sin. The term "baptize" literally means to dip, so when we baptize Scripturally by immersion, we are picturing the three things Jesus did to deliver us from our sin - death, burial, and resurrection. Baptism is also a means of obeying Jesus' command from Matthew 28:19 "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:" Even Jesus, Himself desired to be baptized so that He could demonstrate His own obedience to God the Father. If you have accepted God's free gift of salvation but have never chosen to take this step of obedience, you are encouraged to talk to one of the Pastors soon.
