Examples of Grace in the Bible Moses – Exodus 33:12-17

The value Moses places on God's grace is one that we should learn to emulate.

1. The Declaration of Grace - (12) Moses' plea was based on what He already knew.

a. He asked based on his calling Moses knew that he could not continue the task alone.

b. He acknowledged the relationship and the compelling grace of God Moses' plea was centered in God's grace.

2. The Desire of Grace - (13)

a. It should be Humble **b.** It should be Honoring

The more we know God, the more we understand and receive His grace.

3. The Dependence of Grace - (15)

He realizes that without God's grace, they will fail.

Living life apart from God's grace is a recipe for failure.

God's grace ensures us of His compassion and concern.

4. The Demonstration of Grace - (16)

Deliverance is dependent on God's demonstration of gracious guidance.

"We may be the only bible some people read."

2 Corinthians 3:2

Do not overlook the outward working of God's grace that is seen as evidence of God in your life.

What is the evidence Moses emphasizes? "separated ... from all the people" God's grace is demonstrated by a changed life.

We need the Lord, but our need of the Lord is based on His grace.
