#### **VETERANS DAY**

Veterans Day originated as Armistice Day and marked the end of hostilities of World War I with Germany that occurred at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month. Since World War I had been regarded as the "war to end all wars," President Woodrow Wilson believed the victory had everything to do with lasting peace and declared the commemoration of that day as such to honor those who contributed to the cause of freedom. However, after World War II and the Korean War, Congress recognized a need to expand the meaning of the day to recognize all our Veterans and not just those of World War I. In 1954, the word "Armistice" was replaced with "Veterans" to formally include all Veterans of all American wars in the day of remembrance. It is a day not only to remember those who died in service to our country, but also to recognize those who continue to serve today. Today, we honor all war veterans represented by our congregation.
