Behold your King! Matthew 2:1-12

Jesus is the King and deserves to be considered so in your own life.

- 1. His Kingship is authenticated by Heredity (1:1-25)
- 2. His Kingship is authenticated by Homage (1:1-12)

Authority is often verified by the treatment received from subjects.

A. They Perceived His Glory (2) "we have seen his star."

There was a belief that wonderous things took place in the heavens as a sign of something spectacular on the earth.

"star" - a shining or blazing forth as a star or a celestial body.

This was not your normal star.
Perhaps it is the glory of the Lord?
God's glory is revealed to those whom
God desires to make Himself known.

B. They Pursued His Glory (2) "(we) are come"

God got their interest, and they were willing pursuers.

There was an understanding and a hunger in their heart.

Deuteronomy 4:29

C. They Projected His Glory (10) "they rejoiced"

They were joyful to see the one for whom they diligently sought.

1 Chronicles 16:10

D. They Praised His Glory (11) "fell down and worshipped him"

They demonstrated His worth and gave gifts of adulation.

Jesus, the rightful King of glory should be OUR king and we should demonstrate it.
