Examples of Grace in the Bible The Woman Caught in Adultery John 8:1-11

Grace in this accusation reveals specific truth of how it should look and work in our own lives.

- 1. Self-Examination (4-7)
 Grace should cause us to look first at our own sin before the sin of others.
 Matthew 7:1-5 mote vs. beam
 The word of God is a powerful force toward the conviction of sin.
- 2. Sympathetic Understanding (6b-9) Grace should cause us to approach others with compassion rather than condemnation.

It should be our desire to restore, rather than condemn.

Galatians 6:1

- 3. Secure Expectation (11)
 Grace should cause us to live with
 hope for the future.
 What Jesus said to her that day was
 authoritative and final and it was all of
 His grace through faith.
 Jesus set the adulterous woman free,
 not only from her accusers but also
 from her sin.
- 4. Submissive Devotion (11) Grace should cause us to pursue obedience.

When we properly comprehend grace, there should be a flow of obedience that takes over in our lives.

- Obedience of Gratitude
- Obedience of Love
- Obedience of Devotion

The woman caught in adultery serves as a reminder that no one is beyond God's grace and mercy.
