Sermon notes

Radical Worship Luke 7:36-50

How & why should we engage in radical worship?

1. Radical worship requires <u>repentance</u> & <u>faith</u>.

Luke 5:32 – I came not to call the righteous, but **sinners to repentance**.

Mark 1:15 – The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: **repent ye, and believe the gospel**.

2. Radical worship requires sacrifice.

Romans 12:1 – I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye **present your bodies a living sacrifice**, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service ("spiritual or true worship").

3. Radical worship requires adoration.

1 Chronicles 29:11 – Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and **thou art exalted** as head above all.

4. Radical worship requires <u>radical</u> <u>forgiveness</u>.

Psalm 103:10-12

He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

We should engage in radical worship because we enjoy radical forgiveness.
