Examples of Grace in the Bible Paul's Conversion Acts 9:1-29; Galatians 1:11-24

God's grace served as a transformative force that changed his life and shaped his impact for God.

1. The Reason (need) for Grace (Acts 7:58-8:3)

Saul was antagonistic toward the Gospel and to those who believed it.

He held the garments of those who stoned Stephen (7:58)

He approved of Stephen's death (8:1) He persecuted the believers in Christ (8:3) Saul was in need of a miracle of grace.

- **2.** The Reception of Grace (Acts 9:4-5) God knew what Saul would be like and yet God still reached out to him in grace.
- A. God's grace humbled Saul "he fell to the earth"
- B. God's grace exposed Saul "Who art thou, Lord?"
- 3. The Result (impact) of Grace
- **A. Leading in a new direction** Blessed rather than Blaspheming
- **B. Laboring in a new manner** Preaching rather than persecuting
- C. Looked upon in a new light The Christians were "confounded"
- **D. Living with a new perspective**Grace ruled his life

 - No one is beyond the reach of God's grace.
 - God graciously reveals Himself to us to reveal our own deficiency and need of His grace.
 - God's grace changes us.
 - The Grace Paul received was passed forward to others in his ministry.
