Sermon notes

Grace and Peace - 2 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

When Paul saw the fruit of their relationship with God, which came by grace, he was at peace, and he wanted those of that church to be at peace.

1. The Design of Grace - "work of faith"
This is a work that flows from our faith.
The design for grace is to bring favor that implements change through our faith in Christ.

The "work of faith" is the demonstration of faith.

We can have peace in knowing that God's grace is working in and through us to the power of Christ and the Gospel.

2. The Depth of Grace - "labor of love"
Grace properly administered is love in action.

This is hardship that is experienced for the sake of love.

These Christians had surrendered themselves to the transforming power of God so that they were content to give of themselves to others in sacrifice and in service.

Paul was at peace due to their practice of grace and he wanted them to know that they were faithfully executing grace.

3. The Durability of Grace - "patience of hope"

"patience" does not mean a passive acquiescence, but an active endurance.

It is a "heroic endurance" as one faces obstacles, trials, and persecutions.

The challenge for us is to exercise a measure of patience and endurance in the realm of a confident expectation that God is using us.

Paul's desire was for them to know the peace that comes by grace.
