Grace and Peace – Pt. 6 Romans 1:7-12

Grace and peace serve as a foundation for our spiritual journey and interactions with others.

1. The Grace and resulting Peace of a Solid Witness (8)

This expression of thanks was meant to encourage them in their faith.

We should not undervalue the benefit of encouragement.

Encouragement brings satisfaction to our heart to help us to know that we are making a difference.

2. The Grace and Peace of the Strain of prayer (9-10)

These Christians were seeking to be faithful not knowing that supplication was being made for them to the very throne of God.

We can often feel alone in our journey with God. God cares!

The proud of heart reject the encouragement of prayer from others.**

3. The Grace and Peace from a Supportive community (11-12)

Paul's desire was to impart a blessing to them by encouraging them in person.

He is hoping to be supportive and encouraging by his very presence and ministry of the Word in person.

The goal was for these Christians to become established and strengthened in their faith.

The value of fellowship is not only in the realm of Christianity, but in a local church body of caring believers. (Hebrews 10:25)
