A sure way to receive peace over fear is to understand God's grace in our calling to salvation and service.

Grace and Peace of ...

- 1. A Genuine Faith (3-5)
- a. The continuity of faith (3) It is a favor of God to have the opportunity of faith in our home and in our nation.
- **b.** The dominance of faith (5) Timothy's faith was not weak. His faith was very open and had a dominant place in his life.
- **2. A Recognizable Endowment (6-7)** Remember some things.
- a. Grace for Encouragement (6)
 Paul had recognized Timothy's faith, and
 he and the church had ordained him to the
 Gospel ministry.
- **b. Grace for Enablement (7)**This is a three-fold gift of grace to give him peace over some fear.
 - 1.) The grace of power
 - 2.) The grace of love
 - 3.) The grace of a sound mind
- 3. A Dynamic Testimony (8-11)
 - a. Grace in the afflictions of the Gospel (8)

Willing to share in the ill-treatment of the Gospel

b. Grace in the calling of the Gospel (9)

The calling is literally an invitation to not only salvation, but to holiness which God enables.

c. Grace in the life and light of the Gospel (10)

These words are not only enough for Timothy, but they are enough to encourage us.
