Grace and Peace – Peter - 2 2 Peter 1:1-4

The fortification of the heart and mind in God's grace by a greater knowledge of God helps to combat things that would undermine our faith.

Grace and peace to keep the faith comes from better knowing ...

- **1. God's Person for eternal life (1-2)** The "precious faith" they shared with Peter is something we should not take lightly.
- **a. Jesus is defined by righteousness** To be righteous is to be upright, moral, good, virtuous.
- b. Jesus is a Savior Deliverer
 The righteousness of Jesus has been uploaded to us and to our account.
- **2. God's Power for spiritual life (3)** Salvation is not the end of our spiritual experience. It is just the beginning.
- a. It is Comprehensive in its Source "divine" it is from Jesus Christ.
 - b. It is Comprehensive in its Sufficiency

"all things" –The provision is full and sufficient to combat the false teachers. "life" – the spiritual life God imparts to us "godliness" – being devout, reverent and worshipful - attitude leading to behavior.

- 3. God's Promises for victorious life (4)
 - a. Their value

"exceeding great and precious" - value because of where they come from and what they can accomplish

b. Their virtue

Divine life, the virtuous nature of Christ has been given to us when we get saved.
