Growing in Grace 2 Peter 1:2-3; 3:18

We need to adopt the process whereby we can access the storehouse of grace.

1. It is an Intentional process – "grow"
Not all grace comes and is realized without action on our part.
"knowledge" – to know exactly, completely, through and through This growing is in an active sense.
Grace can be increased as we become more focused in an intentional way to know God.

2. It is an Increasing process – "grow" Grace does not grow, but we grow. Growing relates to increasing, increasing in size, knowledge, maturity, or capability. To grow in grace is not a matter of having God become more gracious to you.

It is the believer who is growing stronger in God's grace.

3. It is an Instructive process – "knowledge"

It involves learning.

You will not effectively grow in grace without growing in the knowledge of God.

It is coming to know him as a person and to develop a deepened relationship with him.

As we grow in the knowledge of the Lord, we will understand better who He is, what He is doing, and how it impacts us.

We are challenged to act responsibly as a believer to utilize God's grace by learning more of God's will and direction for us.
