The Distinctives of Water Baptism

The biblical teaching of baptism speaks to our identification with Jesus Christ and His provision of Salvation to save us from our sin and to serve him obediently.

- A Portrayal of Christ's work of Redemption – Romans 6:3-4 "baptize" –
 - Literal meaning to dip or immerse
- Figurative meaning to be identified with Baptism in the Spirit (Salvation Matthew 3:11; John 1;33; 1 Corinthians 12:13) is illustrated by water baptism (Romans 6:3).
- 2. A Pattern of Obedience to Christ's Example Matthew 3:13-17
 Jesus demonstrated its importance by submitting Himself to be baptized.
 Three reasons why Jesus was baptized (Warren Wiersbe)
 - He gave approval to John's ministry and message
 - He identified Himself with sinners
 - He pictured His future baptism on the cross
- 3. A Profession of Belief in our heart Acts 8:26-39

Two noteworthy characters
Philip – A deacon from the Jerusalem
church who was led by God to witness
Ethiopian - a man of great authority
returning home from Jerusalem
Philip "preached unto him Jesus."
Who He is (Son of God)
Why He came to earth (to save sinners).

What He did on the earth (He died, was buried, and rose again)

BAPTISM

We are observing the Scriptural ordinance of Baptism this morning at the close of the service. Only those who have placed their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as their Savior are candidates for baptism because it is an outward picture to demonstrate what has previously taken place in our heart and what Jesus did to cleanse us from our sin. The term "baptize" literally means to dip, so when we baptize Scripturally by immersion, we are picturing the three things Jesus did to deliver us from our sin - death, burial, and resurrection. Baptism is also a means of obeying Jesus' command from Matthew 28:19 "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:" Even Jesus, Himself desired to be baptized so that He could demonstrate His own obedience to God the Father.

If you have accepted God's free gift of salvation but have never chosen to take this step of obedience, you are encouraged to talk to one of the Pastors, soon.
