God's Tender Mercies Lamentations 3:21-32

Recalling God's Mercy is a worthy praise for Thanksgiving.

- 1. The Lord's Mercies Reveal that bad things do not need to seem Worse than they really are (22)
 - a. Negativity of life says -

"Things cannot get any worse."

Truth of God says -

"Things could be worse, but are not because of God's mercies."

b. Negativity of life says -

"Things cannot get any better."

Truth of God says -

"Things can potentially get better because of God's mercies."

- 2. The Lord's Mercies Restore Joy and confidence in His people (22b 26)
 - a. They are Fail-proof

"fail not" - never finished

"every morning"

b. They are Full

"The Lord is my Portion"

With joy and confidence, we can say, "God is GOOD, ALL the time!" (25)

3. The Lord's Mercies Reward the Faithful (27-32)

Those carried into captivity were given some interesting counsel from God as to how they were to view their captivity (**Jeremiah 27-29**). It was to be viewed as a necessary means of discipline and teaching.

In **Jeremiah 42**, God confirms the value of His discipline.
