Counting the Cost Joshua 1:10-3:5

We will miss out on God's purpose if we are impatient and do not properly count the cost.

1. A Separation to be Confirmed (1:12-18)

Joshua dealing with the two and a half tribes regarding a previous arrangement found in Numbers 32.

Joshua confirms their choice.

This was not a wise choice, but one that God permitted.

They are so close to God's blessings but never possessing any of the land for themselves.

God's will is for us to go all in for holiness and stand separate from sin.

To live on the fringes of obedience is a dangerous place.

2. A Soul to be Considered (2:1-24)

Within the city of Jericho was one life that had faith in God.

Rahab – a woman of faith

Faith proclaimed in Hebrews 11:31

Faith justified by her works in James 2:25

Faith recognized in Christ's genealogy

God's judgment was withheld for Rahab.

Rahab believed in God's supernatural evidences in His people.

3. A Sanctification to be Completed (3:1-5)

The wonder-working power of God always depends on the sanctification of God's people.

"The level on which God meets men depends on the level on which we as Christians are prepared to meet our Lord." (Alan Redpath)

Count the cost! In doing so, we not only see what needs to be spent, but also the value of that which we desire to purchase.
